How Your City's Aid Amount is Determined

Your city will be placed into one of three categories depending on the size of its population.

The formula used to determine your city's LGA amount will use different factors depending on which size category your city is in.

Other factors may impact your city's LGA amount, regardless of city size

Small City

Population less than 2,500



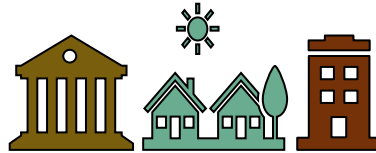
City population

Medium City

Population between 2,500 - 11,000



City population

% of housing built before 1940

Decline in population from peak population level

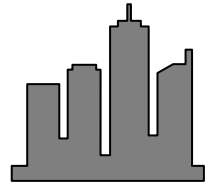
Commercial/industrial/public utility market value as % of total market value

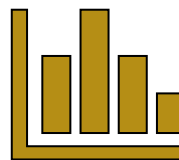
Population age index
